Calvary Bible College was founded in the year 1970 at Mussourie, Uttar Pradesh by Rev. Harry E. Scism through a vision from the Lord. It was named 'Calvary Bible Institute' just as it was revealed to him. In the year 1973 it was shifted to Shillong, Meghalaya and Graduate in Theology (G.Th.) degree was offered at its initial stage. About 80% of our graduates from this institution are serving the Lord in Fulltime and they are useful instruments for the spreading of the Oneness truth. The institution was upgraded to B.Th. level in the year 2005 and the medium of learning also changed from Mizo to English. Many of our B.Th. Graduates are also serving in the ministry now. Our heartfelt gratitude goes to our District leaders who have shown our graduates the areas where they could be working for God.

2013 Graduation Day was held on December 1, 2013 (Sunday). **Rev. Prince Matthiasz, Coordinator of Global Association of Theological Studies (GATS) and also General Superintendent, Sri Lanka** was the Speaker on this special occasion. The matter Concerning application for affiliation with GATS which was already processed by our General leaders was renewed and discussed with the Coordinator. By the time when this Report was prepared in the month of January 27 at the GATS meeting at St. Louis, USA, **Global Association of Theological Studies (GATS)** had approved our affiliation. Some of the activities apart from the Teaching ministry during the year 2013 are as follows:

The College session started on March 1, 2013. We have 33 students altogether. These students were from different parts of the country, viz. Mizoram, Manipur, Tripura, West Bengal, North Bengal, Nagaland, and Assam. Among the students there were three girls and thirty boys. Orientation programme was conducted on March 4.

General Conference at Vaivakawn, Aizawl: For the first time in the history of Calvary Bible College, all the students were taken to participate the General Conference which was held at Vaivakawn, Aizawl from April 18 to 21. The students formed a Choir and presented beautiful songs which was highly appreciated by the audience of the conference.

Mission Expo 2013: As our usual practice, Second year students were sent to the Missions Fields on a Mission Exposure so that they might have an experience of the work of the Mission and have a burden for it during their Semester break from July 1 to 12. The students were sent this year to the Dimapur Mission Field. They were required to give a written and oral report of their experiences in the field when they return. The ministry was a fruitful one. It was learnt that during this Missions Exposure new members were added to the Church and a many people received the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Some of the students received God's call and committed their lives to be a fulltime missionary after their completion of their studies.

Spiritual Emphasis Week: Spiritual Emphasis Week this year was conducted from August 6-9 with the theme "**Turning the World Upside Down**". Pastor Samson Thurr, South East Nagaland District Missions Director was the speaker. The Lecturers presented Strategy papers on topics such as 1) *Turning the world upside down through Christian living* 2) *Turning the world upside down through women's participation in Ministry* 3) *Turning the world upside down through Information & communication technology* 4) *Turning the world upside down through Pentecostal Preaching & Evangelism* 5) *Turning the world upside down through Oneness Spirituality*. The students conducted Bible Study on topics such as 1) *Significance of the leadership/ministry of Joshua as an example to turn the world upside down* 2) *Significance of the leadership/ministry of Gideon*

as an example to turn the world upside down. Every one of us experienced many blessings from the Lord as we spend every day from 6.00 A.M to 8.00 P.M. in fellowship with Him.

Apart from the above report we also have different activities such as: Celebration of India Independence Day (August 15), Celebration of Teachers' Day (September 5), and Sports Week (Sept.18 - 20).

CBC Day: For the first time, CBC Day was observed on September 8. About 40 units of blood was donated by our students in the name of CBC at NEIGRHIMS hospital. The hospital staff and doctors expressed their gratitude to our College.

Inauguration of Library: With the permission from the Theological Education Board and the Executive Board, Library Building Project drive was organized in the year 2012 and the building was completed and occupied this year. The inaugural function was held on December 1, 2013 at 2.00 P.M. The General Superintendent, Rev. V.L. Dika Sailo inaugurated the Library. We are truly grateful to the Districts, Sections, Locals and individuals who had contributed generously for this cause.
